

Positive Behaviour for Learning

Universal Behaviour Support

The first step in facilitating standards of positive behaviour is communicating those standards to all students. At Charleville State High School we emphasise the importance of directly teaching students the behaviours we want them to demonstrate at school. Communicating behavioural expectations is a form of universal support – a strategy directed towards all students which is designed to prevent problem behaviour and to provide a framework for responding to unacceptable behaviour.
