



Enter you MIS ID login and password. (This is the same log on that you use for access to the internet at school, the Learning Place, your email etc.).


If you are directed to the Responsible Use Agreement page (shown below), read through the information, and then "Accept Agreement"

In this document we are only interested in your Timetable. You also may or may not see the Student Resources on the right hand side. It doesn't matter if you do or don't at this stage.

Click on Student Timetable Weekly and your timetable will open up in a new window.
